Responding to developments in the Gallery and external events, the programme covers a comprehensive range of free and paid events including tours, talks, lectures, creative workshops, cross-arts events and Friday Lates.

The post holder will have responsibility for creative programming, project management and day-to-day financial management. The role involves working across the Gallery especially with Curatorial, Scientific and Conservation departments to develop programmes, and with Information, Digital Media, Marketing, Press, Development, Visitor Services & Security departments and AV Technicians to communicate and deliver events. S/he will have an understanding of interpreting paintings and will be expected to deliver talks and lectures to support the wide-ranging activities across the department.
