In line with the overall Preservation Management Plan, you will oversee a small team of technicians and volunteers, supervise contractors, prepare maintenance specifications and resolve technical issues. In addition, we need you to train ship-keeping staff, contribute to the development of a long-term maintenance plan and ensure the highest Health & Safety standards.

Along with a relevant technical or engineering qualification, you will need to demonstrate how your experience equips you to look after a rigged historic ship. Strong communication, team leadership and contract management skills are also important, as well as a good working knowledge of materials science (particularly iron corrosion) and a 'hands on' approach.
