The National Gallery's collection of Western European paintings is one of the richest and most comprehensive in the world. Its public programme attracts 80,000 adults every year and offers life-long learning opportunities to adults of all levels of experience - from those new to art through to scholars. Taking the collection as inspiration, the programme inspires critical and creative engagement and learning through art history and creative practice. Responding to developments in the Gallery and external events, the programme covers a comprehensive range of free and paid events including tours, talks, lectures, creative workshops, cross-arts events and Friday Lates.

The Adult Learning Officer will have responsibility for creative programming, project management and day-to-day financial management. The role involves working across the Gallery especially with Curatorial, Scientific and Conservation departments to develop programmes, and with Information, Digital Media, Marketing, Press, Development, Visitor Services & Security departments and AV Technicians to communicate and deliver events. S/he will demonstrate excellent knowledge of western art and an understanding of current issues and trends in adult learning. The post holder will also be required to demonstrate an aptitude for adapting their approach to the needs and knowledge levels of the audience. S/he will be expected to deliver talks and lectures as part of this role.
