



Natural History Museum

We are looking to recruit an experienced SQL DBA/Developer for 8 months to work on an international European funded project OpenUp! (<http://open-up.eu/>). The aim of the project is to make available through the Europeana portal (<http://www.europeana.eu/>) assets including images, movies and sound files from institutes in 12 EU countries.

The project is in the final year with an aggregator developed by an Austrian partner harvesting records from content providers and delivering to the European portal. The aggregator integrates with an SQL database and we need to continue to develop and make sustainable this central infrastructure while developing reports for content providers.

The post will require excellent technical skills in Microsoft SQL Server management, SSIS, SSRS, database analysis, database backup and recovery. As part of their duties the post holder will learn how to perform all the steps to deliver data from provider to portal and then document and manage the task a couple of times before helping to train others in the task . Exposure to Linux, Drupal, Pentaho Data Integration. MySQL and XML would be beneficial. Good problem solving and, documentation skills are essential.

You will work with European colleagues and might be expected to attend one or two physical European meetings held on the continent as well as attending regular skype and e-meetings. To be successful you will need to be self-motivated; able to work with minimum supervision; produce high quality work; have excellent communication and project management skills.

The successful candidates will be available to start Monday 1st July 2013.
