You must have professional knowledge of all aspects of collections care, including best practice standards and relevant information systems. A confident communicator and organiser, with numeracy and logistical skills, who can influence and work effectively with a range of internal and external stakeholders, you will have proven experience of devising and managing projects, budgets and staff, and developing and managing museum storage and collection care on a significant scale. You will be able to define and implement practical solutions to collections care problems, have relevant Microsoft Office skills - including use of databases - and will be able to work to deadlines under pressure.
