With collections of unparalleled scale and significance, the National Railway Museum is one of the greatest museums of its kind anywhere in the world. Outside London, it is one of the UK's most visited national museums, receiving approximately 750,000 visitors per year. It has a further 200,000 visitors at its second site Locomotion in Shildon, County Durham. The outstanding collections, including 116 locomotives and 118 other items of rolling stock, tell the story of railways from the Rocket to the Bullet, and aim to engage audiences of all ages.

The Director is responsible for leading the Museum to ensure that it continues to enhance its reputation as one of the world's foremost transport museums. He or she will oversee an engaged and committed team, seeking to nurture innovation, engage new audiences, develop new funding streams and manage critical relationships with external stakeholders - including the railway industry and heritage sector – and donors.
